### WAGON LOADING OPENER

ANNOUNCER 1: (DURING LOAD) Hello to all you nature lovin', hay wagon ridin', paintball shootin' pals of Uesugi Farms! Welcome to our Paint Ball Hay Ride! When everybody's onboard and ready, we'll be heading out of here toward the giant paint ball pumpkin patch like a bat outta H-E-Double Hockey sticks! Or, you know, like a bat driving a tractor hauling a hay wagon full of wild paint ball enthusiasts. Whatever . . .

### WAGON LOADING CLOSER

ANNOUNCER 1: (AT END OF LOAD) While we're getting ready, I need everybody -- yeah, that's means you, too, wise guy -- to hear about all our safety precautions. First off, for your own safety and the safety of everybody and everything in a 5 mile radius, please be careful with the paintball guns. Just leave 'em in place until it's time to use them. You have my sworn promise you'll know the very second you can use them. I mean, c'mon! That's what we're all here for, right? Also remain seated at all times. This can be a bumpy trip and it'll be more fun in the wagon than falling out of the wagon. While you're at it, keep your hands, arms, feet, legs, and head inside. If for some reason you lose your hat or sunglasses or anything, just holler up at the driver to stop. If they can, they'll wait a second so you can go back and get what you dropped.

ANNOUNCER 1: OK, ready? Giant paintball pumpkin patch, here we come!

PUMPKIN BALL PATCH APPROACH #1

ANNOUNCER 1: It's going to take us a couple minutes to get to the paintball pumpkin patch, so I guess I'll just turn on the radio and find something good to listen to so's we can relax on the ride . . .

SFX: CLICK!

SFX: SOUND OF FAST SEARCHING FOR A RADIO STATION. FINALLY THE FINAL FEW SECONDS OF A UESUGI FARMS RADIO SPOT. FADES. THEN

ANNOUNCER 2: Uesugi Sam is on the air!

RADIO DJ: And we're back with more music! This is your old pal Uesugi Sam broadcasting to you live on Radio Uesugi. I hope everyone is having a rockin' great time whatever you're doing and where ever you are. Uhhhh . . . make that, "almost where ever you are." We've been getting some pretty strange reports of (ECHO EFFECT) weird stuff (NORMAL) going on out there along Monterey Road, out there near the giant pumpkin patch. Ha! Stuff like sightings of leafy monsters and giant insects and, you know, (ECHO EFFECT) weird stuff (NORMAL) like that. Yeah, I'll bet! Sneaking too many Halloween mini-candy bars, I'll bet'cha, machining people see things that – obviously – aren't there! Hey, if there's anybody out there who knows anything at all about this, give old Uesugi Sam a call on our special "weird story" call line. Now, it's time for more music! Ba-boom!

MUSIC: PUBLIC DOMAIN ROCK MUSIC. FADES.

PUMPKIN BALL PATCH APPROACH #2

SFX: SOUND OF FAST SEARCHING FOR A RADIO STATION.  
THEN . . .

ANNOUNCER 2: Uesugi Sam is on the air!

RADIO DJ: Aw-right, babies! That was “The Kale of Cthulhu” from local hard-rockers The Lettuce League. I was hoping someone had the bird’s eye lowdown – whatever the heck that means – on the (ECHO EFFECT) weird stuff (NORMAL) going on down around the giant pumpkin patch. Hey, looks like we’ve got a caller on the line. Hello? Who is this?

SFX: PHONE CONNECTION

CALLER #1: (PHONE FILTER THROUGHOUT) Uh, hullo? Am I, like, on the radio and stuff? This is, like, SO audio-only!

RADIO DJ: You’re on the air with Uesugi Sam!

CALLER #1: Well, that’s not my fault now, is it? I, like, just called, and stuff. You’re the doofus who answered, I mean, duh!

RADIO DJ: Uh . . . right. So, what can you tell us about all these bogus reports of (ECHO EFFECT) weird stuff (NORMAL) going on around the giant pumpkin patch? It’s all a big hoax, right?

CALLER #1: First of all, Point “A,” the echo effect is, like, completely a cheap gag, OK? People don’t go in for those kinds-a lame things on the radio anymore.

RADIO DJ: I like my echo . . .

CALLER #1: And like Issue Two is that, all the creepy stories and, like, stuff aren't bogus, radio guy. There's all kinds of weird stuff going on around here, like, for real! Great big giant, like, red and green glowing cockroaches and spiders and stuff, just to start off with. And my friend Mellissa, like, she swears she saw a couple of, like, great big leafy monster-y guys sneaking around. Being all, like, monster-y and sneaky and stuff.

RADIO DJ: Wait, what? You mean there's really something going on out there? Wow! This is incredible!

CALLER #1: Ya, I know, hunh? So cool! And, like, what's that word?

RADIO DJ: Uh . . . "creepy?"

CALLER #1: I was gonna say, "terribly unusual," but that'll work. Hey, look, this has been just oodles of fun, but I've gotta go. (OFF MIC) Like, Mellissa! Are you going to go shoot at giant leafy monsters without me? Oh, m'gawd! Like, wait up!

SFX: CELL PHONE DISCONNECT

RADIO DJ: Well, that was . . . I don't know what that was. Something's going on here. Lemme play some more music while I try to get to the bottom of this! We'll be back!

MUSIC: PUBLIC DOMAIN ROCK MUSIC. FADES.

PUMPKIN BALL PATCH APPROACH #3

SFX: SOUND OF FAST SEARCHING FOR A RADIO STATION.  
THEN . . .

ANNOUNCER 2: Uesugi Sam is on the air!

RADIO DJ: I'm back again and that was the latest release from the first lady of agricultural soul, Miss Morgan Hill. So, listen! This is huge news, gang! While the music was playing I'm told that we have an actual scientist with one of the big research companies up north there call in to us to explain what's going on. I'm sure he'll be able to shed some light on the weird stuff! Hey! My echo! What happened to my echo!

SFX: PHONE CONNECTION / STATIC

RADIO DJ Oh, this can't be good.

MUSIC: SPOOKY PUMPKIN BALL MUSIC SLOWLY UP AND UNDER

Caller #2 (PHONE FILTER THROUGHOUT) Hello? Am I on the air?  
Bwahahahaha!

SFX: LOUD FEEDBACK

RADIO DJ Aw! Feedback! Caller, please turn down your radio!

SFX: LOUD FEEDBACK OUT

Caller #2 Can you hear me now? Is this any better? Bwahahaha!

RADIO DJ: Well, we can hear you, but I'm not sure that's any better. Uh, who . . .

CALLER #2: Is this Uesugi Sam? Wow, I can't believe it's really you! Long time listener, first time caller! I'm Dr. Fungi from the Creepy Institute for Making Things Much, Much Bigger! Bwahahaha!

RADIO DJ: You're, uh, a scientist, right? Doctor . . . ?

CALLER #2: Fungi.

RADIO DJ: OK, great! So, look, I know that a serious man of science such as yourself . . .

CALLER #2: Bwahahahaha! I mean . . . yes, go on.

RADIO DJ: Anyway, people have been saying some crazy stuff about, and you're going to laugh . . . BUT PLEASE DON'T!

CALLER #2: Bwa . . . oh. Bummer.

RADIO DJ: People have been telling us that there are giant, leafy monsters and . . . Hey, do I hear music playing? What is that?

CALLER #2: That's creepy-yet-exciting attacking monster show-down music. That's how you know that creepy stuff is about to happen! C'mon, Sam, don't you ever go to the movies?

RADIO DJ: Uh-oh. Um, people have been telling us that there are giant, leafy monsters and giant red and green bugs and spiders. Impossible, uh . . . right?

CALLER #2: Right! Impossibly wonderful! Don't you see, Uesugi Sam? We at the Creepy Institute for Making Things Much, Much Bigger have been building our terrifying army of creatures to send out to do our evil bidding! Yes, I can see them now! There, in the giant pumpkin patch! Blood thirsty giant red and/or green insects! Blood thirsty green and/or red spiders! And our army of giant leafy monster-y men! Bwahahahaha! Run wild, my preeties! Bwahahahaha! Hey, look, Uesugi Sam, this has been fun, but I gotta go! Oh, one more thing!

RADIO DJ: What? What?

CALLER #2: Could-ja play more Chuck Berry? I really dig him! Bwahahaha!

SFX: CELL PHONE DISCONNECT

MUSIC: OUT

RADIO DJ: This is terrible! Quick, any of you listeners who might be in the giant pumpkin patch and riding in hay wagons equipped with paintball guns, you are our only hope! When you see any of those giant bugs and spiders and terrible leafy monster-y guys, take aim and shoot! And then, because I know you are very polite, be sure to give someone else in your wagon a chance to shoot too, OK? I mean, monsters, yeah, but let's all share! OK, rock 'n rollers . . . GO GET 'EM!!!

MUSIC: SPOOKY PUMPKIN BALL MUSIC SLOWLY UP AND UNDER DURING THE PAINTBALL SECTION OF THE HAY RIDE

PUMPKIN BALL PATCH EXIT #1

SFX: SOUND OF FAST SEARCHING FOR A RADIO STATION.  
THEN

ANNOUNCER 2: Uesugi Sam is on the air!

RADIO DJ: Listens! Listens! You did it! You just saved us all from a terrible invasion of creepy giant bugs and monsters! I knew I could count on you guys! (TEARING UP) You guys are just so amazing!

SFX: BIG, WET NOSE BLOWING

RADIO DJ: You magnificent, uh, paintball-shootin' hay ridin', monster-blastin' uh, you know, people. Take a break, relax, you've earned it! Here, I'll play a special tune for you, roots music, all the way from me to you!

MUSIC: PUMPKIN BALL MUSIC CONTINUES DURING EXIT RIDE

PUMPKIN BALL PATCH EXIT #2

SFX: SOUND OF FAST SEARCHING FOR A RADIO STATION.  
THEN

ANNOUNCER 2: Uesugi Sam is on the air!

RADIO DJ: Good news! I've got the sheriff on the phone. She probably wants to thank me for saving the day. Uh, I mean, thank all of you because of what you did to save us from the invasion of the giant pumpkin patch (ECHO EFFECT) weird stuff (NORMAL)! Hey! I got my echo back!

SFX: PHONE CONNECTION

CALLER #3: (PHONE FILTER THROUGHOUT) Hey! HEY! Is that Uesugi Sam?

RADIO DJ: Right you are, Sheriff. On the Air!

CALLER #3: Yeah, whatever, buddy. Hey, yer in big trouble, pal!

RADIO DJ: Aw, sheriif, you are welcome! Uh . . . say what?

CALLER #3: Are you the dingbat who was telling people to go shooting up giant nasty bugs and monsters?

RADIO DJ: Well, yeah, it was. Did I do anything, I mean, did those people who I've never seen before in my life in that hay wagon do anything wrong?

CALLER #3: Uh-hunh. Ever think there might be a particular season for shooting at monsters? Maybe the need for a giant bug hunting license? Hunh? D'ya think on that, Sam?

RADIO DJ: I can't say that I ever have . . .

CALLER #3: Ignorance of the laws about shooting monsters is no excuse. I'm gonna need to see you down at the sheriff's office pretty quick, bucko.

RADIO DJ: But what about all that (ECHO EFFECT) weird stuff (NORMAL) down there in the giant pumpkin . . .

CALLER #3: Speaking of which, you got a valid operator's permit for that cheesy echo effect? Sam, yer in a heap of trouble. We'll be seein' ya soon, Sam!

SFX: CELL PHONE DISCONNECT

RADIO DJ: Uh . . . oops! Well, I guess it's time for me to end the show for now. But in the meanwhile, keep an eye out for . . . (ECHO EFFECT) weird stuff (NORMAL)! (FADING OFF MIC) Hey! Since when do I need a license for echo? Really? I do?

PUMPKIN BALL PATCH EXIT #2

ANNOUNCER 1: (AS WAGON IS PULLING UP TO THE FINAL STOP) I'd like to thank you all for coming with us on the Uesugi Farms Paintball Hay Wagon Ride! You did a great job, but I need you all to stay seated until we come to a complete stop. And please be careful! After all you've been through, I don't want you to get hurt just getting off the wagon. Make sure you have all of your personal belongings with you. Give a hand to the person next you as you hop down, it's a friendly thing to do. Thanks for joining us, folks!
